

## JUST SO YOU KNOW

**Who?** All children who have **completed** grades 3, 4, 5, or 6 regardless of race, creed or national origin.

**When?** Monday, June 21 to Friday, June 25, 2010. Check-in is Monday at 3:00 p.m. (please eat before arriving at camp). Final rally is Friday at 10:00 a.m. —parents and friends are encouraged to attend. Check out follows the rally at approximately noon. All campers must see camp personnel before leaving the campgrounds to check out.

**Where?** Brown City Campgrounds.

**What to Bring?** Please mark everything with child's name

- ♦ Clothing—Modest play clothes, warm sweater/jacket, hangers, shoes (2 pairs), changes of underwear and socks, pajamas, raincoat or umbrella, swimsuit (please, no girls' two-piece suits)
- ♦ Bedding—Two single sheets and blankets or sleeping bag, pillow, mattress pad or rubber sheets (if needed)
- ♦ Towels— wash cloth, bath and hand towels
- ♦ Hygiene items—soap in plastic box, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, brush, plastic cup
- ♦ Chapel items—Bible, notebook, pen or pencils
- ♦ Extras—camera, ball glove, flashlight
- ♦ **DO NOT BRING** cell phones, knives, candy, comic books, radios, CD, MP3, or tape players or any electronic toys.

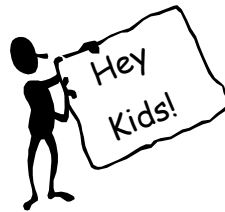

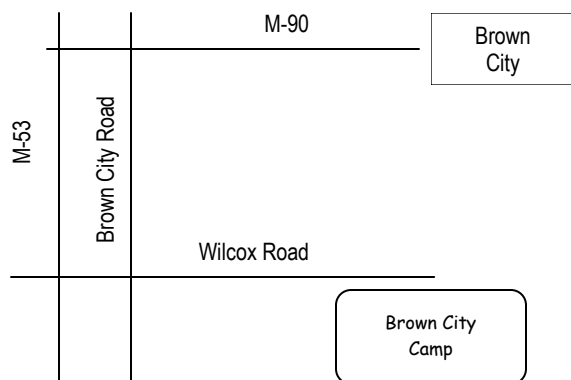
